United Way 211 is a free, confidential helpline that connects callers to resources to meet their needs, such as food, housing, clothes, and transportation.

Last year, United Way 211 answered more than 213,000 calls for help.



### Center for Excellence IN SOCIAL SERVICES

United Way provides educational programming, shares best practices, and offers technical assistance to area nonprofits so they can improve their service offerings to the community.

Since its launch in January 2022, the Center for Excellence has educated 630 nonprofit professionals.
